



Regional Child Abuse and Child Neglect Prevention Council

Appeal Process

Any organization that applies to an Ohio Regional Child Abuse and Child Neglect Prevention Council for funding and receives notification that they were not awarded the funding, has the option to appeal the council's decision.

If an organization wishes to appeal the council's decision, the organization must submit a written letter to the council's administrative agent as well as the chairperson of the council within 10 calendar days of the notification of the council's decision.

After receiving a timely letter from an organization wishing to appeal a council funding decision, the regional prevention council's administrative agent will confer with the chairperson of the council. The chairperson of the council will then determine whether to bring the appeal letter before the council or to bring it before the council's executive team (administrative agent, chairperson, and vice chairperson).

The council or the council's executive team, within a reasonable amount of time, will then act on the letter or take no action. The council's administrative agent and the council chairperson will then send a letter to the organization that submitted the appeal letter informing them of the council's decision.
